#### Initiative title \*

Education Arcade: Developer Tools Refresh

#### Provide a short summary of the work that was completed as part of this initiative.

Education Arcade was able to refresh its developer tools to create free, interactive online safety educational resources for tamariki in New Zealand. As part of this initiative we developed two online safety games called "CIA secure" and "Safe Surfing". We also developed a 20 online safety lesson program for schools, including a detailed teachers guide to aid in implementing the learnings from these lessons. Each module consists of a learning task, and a practical activity so students were able to implement what they had learnt from our course. 2,000 schools were invited to use our content for free to enhance their lesson plans, which included topics such as: starting out secure, cyber crimes, social media safety, password protection, personal data protection, hackers 101, harmful digital communications, safe online gaming, stranger danger, and digital citizenship.

Between March 2023 and March 2024, we saw a total visitor volume of 123,327, a 69.6% increase from the same period last year (85,886).
